Theme: Regional Revitalization and Urban Productivity

Organizer: Reitaku University / JSRSAI

Date: Saturday, October 8, 15:00-16:30, 2022

Venue: Reitaku University, Bldg. Kaede 1503 (with online real time distribution)

Aim:

In Kashiwa City, the Kashiwanoha area has been certified as a smart city and is working to establish a new urban development method, while working on the regeneration of the central city area around Kashiwa Station, which is represented by the withdrawal of Kashiwa Sogo. In case of Kashiwa City, which has two completely different typical urban areas, we focused on the relationship between the design of the central city area for revitalization, the development of smart cities and the interaction with the central city area, human capital, environmental resources, regional income, and industrial policy. At the symposium, Mr. Atsushi DEGUCHI (Professor of the University of Tokyo, Chairman of the City Planning Institute of Japan) will be invited as a keynote speaker to discuss the possibility of regional creation from urban design. And from Kashiwa city office (under adjustment), we will be introduced about introduce the development and prospects of the regional revitalization project. In the panel discussion, Mr. Kazuhiko YAMAKAWA (Reitaku University) was invited to discuss the possibility of regional revitalization in Kashiwa, including the SDGs. Also, we would like to invite Mr. IMAMURA (under adjustment) from Yabuki Town, Fukushima Prefecture to introduce examples of SDGs utilization in rural areas. We would like to deepen the discussion on the productivity of cities by comparing the role of SDGs with rural areas.

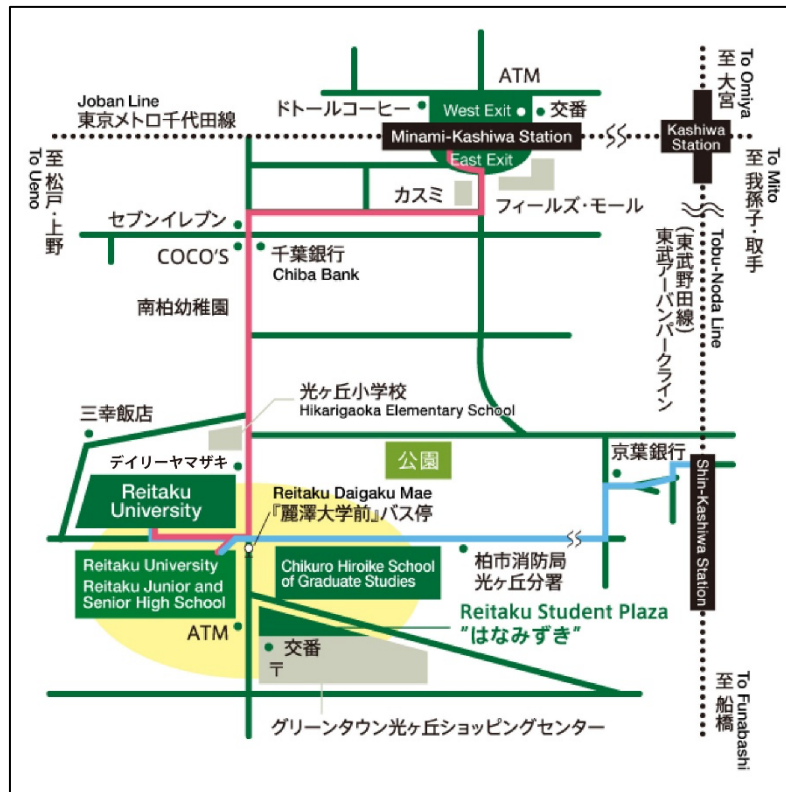

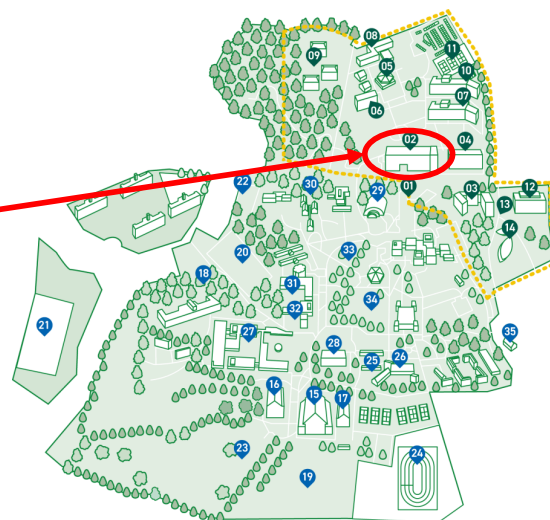
